				<p>17.2 Gateshead School Sport Partnership (PREMIUM SLA)</p> <p>Available only to primary schools, this SLA was conceived in direct response to the implementation of Sport Premium funding to support schools in the effective use of this resource. This has a clear focus on Physical Education, helping schools to achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of Physical Education and sport via the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 days of subject support from a Physical Education specialist.</li> <li>Access to a cluster programme of activity delivered by a School Sport Co-ordinator (SSCo) to manage cluster programmes of activity.
