Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to school. I hope you and your family had a wonderful summer and are ready for what I hope will be a stimulating year ahead. I am very much looking forward to teaching your child in Year 5.

Here is some information that will be useful for this term:

- ❖ **Trumpet lessons** will take place on Fridays. Y5 is very privileged in being the only class to have this opportunity.
- ❖ **PE lessons** are on **Thursday and Friday** during the **Autumn Term**. Children must bring to school their P.E kit (white t-shirt, black shorts and trainers.) The children will be outside for the majority of their sessions so will require a warm sweatshirt and dark tracksuit bottoms when the weather is cooler.
- ❖ **Reading folders** need to be in school every day. Children will have the opportunity to read daily, so they need their current book and reading record book in their folder. They will read with me on the day written in the front of their record book.
- ❖ **Maths and Grammar homework** will be given every Friday (starting on Friday 13th September) This should be completed and returned no later than the following Thursday.
- ❖ **Spellings** – These will be given to your child on a Monday and they will be tested on the Friday. Please ask for replacement spellings if your child misplaces theirs.
